Application for Funding for the Construction of new Skate Park at Thomson Street Sporting Complex – Sussex Inlet

Council strongly supports this application for funding towards the construction of a Skate Park at the Thompson St Sporting Complex in Sussex Inlet.

Sussex Inlet is a relatively isolated coastal community with a high young population. It is approximately 50 kms to the nearest Skate facility. The area has limited youth infrastructure and this project seeks to improve the range of facilities for local young people.

The community has established a Committee to co-ordinate the development and funding for this facility.

Council has formally resolved to support the construction of the skate park. Council has also committed \$50,000 to this project, along with support through land survey of the site.

The project will be constructed under the State Environmental Planning Policy (Infrastructure) 2007, and this project is considered by Council to be "shovel ready".
